New Bills Introduced Week of March 11-15

- <u>SB548 Requiring a concealed carry license to lawfully carry a concealed handgun and exempting colleges and universities from the public buildings requirements under the personal and family protection act.</u>
- <u>SB549 Requiring criminal history record checks for all sales of firearms and providing criminal penalties for violations thereof.</u>
- <u>SB550 Prohibiting persons under 21 years of age from purchasing and possessing</u> semiautomatic rifles with high capacity ammunition magazines.
- SB551 Creating the crime of unlawful storage of a firearm and providing criminal penalties for violations thereof.
- <u>HB2835</u> Requiring cities of the first class and counties that have cities of the first class to adopt, by ordinance or resolution, respectively, law enforcement vehicle pursuit protocols and requiring chiefs of police and county sheriffs to propose such protocols for adoption or amendment.
- <u>HB2838</u> Authorizing the director of alcoholic beverage control to issue licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor to persons convicted of a felony if such conviction is more than 10 years old.
